Major changes to collection days starting in 2024

Vaudreuil-Dorion, December 13, 2023 – Changes will be made to collection days in Vaudreuil-Dorion starting in January 2024. At the same time, the numerical naming of sectors has been revised to avoid confusion with districts. Sectors will now be named by letters rather than numbers (1 becomes A, 2 becomes B and so on).

The changes had to be made following the award of a new five-year collection contract. Materials will now be collected according to the following schedule:

Collection	Day
Organic materials	Monday Every two weeks up to and including April 8 Sectors C, D and E: start Tuesday, January 2, due to statutory vacation Sectors A and B: start January 8
Garbage	Wednesday Every two weeks Sectors C, D and E: begins January 3 Sectors A and B: start January 10
Bulky waste	Thursday Once a month Sector A: first Thursday of the month Sector B: second Thursday of the month Sector C: third Thursday of the month Sectors D and E: fourth Thursday of the month
Recycling	Friday Weekly for all sectors

Winter organics collection

Organics will be collected every two weeks during the winter season (mid-November to mid-April each year). A significant drop in the amount of material collected during this period, combined with the delivery of larger format bins, has prompted the Town to implement this new measure. Collection will resume on a weekly basis as of April 15. It should be noted that, as green residues are now accepted in

the organic waste collection program, only two green residue collections have been maintained in the spring and three in the fall.

Residents are invited to consult the municipal calendar, to be mailed out in the next few days, in which the collections are clearly identified. They can also refer to the Address Search at ville.vaudreuil-dorion.qc.ca (which will be updated in early January) and to the Collections and Schedules page.
